ITEM 5. OTHER EVENTS.

Terms of the acquisition of The Popcorn Factory by 1-800-FLOWERS.COM ("the Company") include a total purchase price of approximately \$12.2 million comprised of \$7.3 million to retire The Popcorn Factory's outstanding debt and 353,003 shares of 1-800-FLOWERS.COM's common stock issued to The Popcorn Factory's former shareholders.

Due to the seasonality of The Popcorn Factory's business - in which a majority of its revenues come in the calendar fourth quarter (the Company's fiscal second quarter) - the Company anticipates a reduction of approximately \$1 million from its original guidance of \$8 million positive EBITDA (earnings before income tax, depreciation and amortization) during its fiscal fourth quarter ending June 30, 2002. The Company anticipates that, during its fiscal 2003 year beginning July 1, 2002, The Popcorn Factory will contribute revenues of approximately \$30 million and positive EBITDA of approximately \$2.4 million.
