Explanation of Responses:

- (1) 60,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$24.00 were granted on February 17, 2000, and vest on an annual schedule of 20%, 20%, 30% and 30%, beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date.
- (2) 120,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$12.44 were granted on November 1, 2000. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on February 2, 2003 and ending on November 1, 2004.
- (3) 40,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$9.625 were granted on April 4, 2001. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on July 5, 2003 and ending on April 4, 2005.
- (4) 102,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$7.07 were granted on September 29, 2003. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on December 29, 2005 and ending on September 29, 2007.
- (5) 60,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$4.99 were granted on June 14, 2004. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on September 14, 2006 and ending on June 14, 2008.
- (6) 60,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$5.70 were granted on November 26, 2004. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on February 26, 2007 and ending on November 26, 2008.
- (7) 40,000 stock options with an exercise price of \$4.57 were granted on January 10, 2005. These options vest in two installments of 25% each on the first and second anniversary of the grant date, and in eight subsequent quarterly installments of 6.25% each, commencing on April 10, 2007 and ending on January 10, 2009.
- (8) 80,000 restricted stock unit were granted on September 19, 2005 pursuant to AsiaInfo Holdings, Inc.'s 2005 Stock Incentive Plan and vest on an annual schedule of 25% each, beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. Upon each vesting, one share of common stock shall be issuable for each restricted stock unit on such vesting date.
- (9) 300,000 restricted stock units were granted on November 20, 2006. These stock units are performance based and will be allocated among five different performance goals of the Company over a four-year period.
- (10) 247,500 restricted stock units were granted on March 16, 2009. These stock units are performance based and will be allocated by one performance goal of the Company over a three-year period from October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2011.
