- Number of shares withheld to cover withholding taxes associated with the issuance of 17,820 shares of Issuer common stock in settlement
- (1) of an equal number of vested performance restricted stock units previously credited to the reporting person's account in the Issuer's Non-qualified Deferred Compensation ("NQDC") Plan. The units had previously been reported in Table I.

The vested performance restricted stock units result from awards under the registrant's equity compensation plan during the years 2003-2012, with 29,024 units eligible to vest over performance periods ending December 31, 2013-2017.
