Management believes that this presentation of EBITDA provides useful information regarding our results of operations because it assists in analyzing and benchmarking the performance and value of our business. Although we use EBITDA as a financial measure to assess the performance of our business, the use of EBITDA is limited because it does not include certain material costs, such as depreciation, amortization and taxes, necessary to operate our business. EBITDA should be considered in addition to, and not as a substitute for, net income as calculated in accordance with GAAP as a measure of performance.
