Mr. Pacelli will also continue to lead the Company's investor relations, legal and intellectual property groups. Going forward, other operating responsibilities will be split between Terry Gregg, DexCom's Chief Executive Officer, and Kevin Sayer, DexCom's President, and DexCom will not have a principal operating officer.
