Item 8.01 Other Events.

On May 24, 2013, Pacific Bell Telephone Company, a subsidiary of the registrant AT&T Inc. (“AT&T”), provided irrevocable notice to The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A. (as successor to First Trust of California, National Association), as trustee (the “Trustee”), to redeem all the outstanding 7.375% Debentures due July 15, 2043 with CUSIP number 694032AV5, in accordance with the terms of the Indenture with the Trustee. The redemption date will be July 15, 2013, and the redemption amount is equal to 102.89% of the principal amount of the Debentures to be redeemed.

AT&T expects the aggregate cash payment to be approximately \$309 million, including principal of \$300 million and a call premium of approximately \$9 million. The redemption of this debt is expected to be funded by cash on hand.
