Relevant Securities in Issue

ScottishPower announces, in accordance with Rule 2.10 of the City Code on Takeovers and Mergers, 19 March 2007 it had the following securities in issue:

Ordinary share capital 1,489,372,170 shares of 42p each ("ordinary shares").

The ISIN reference number for these securities is GB00B125RK88.

US\$ perpetual subordinated convertible bonds US\$700 million in aggregate ("convertible bonds"). These securities are XS0171162075 (Reg S) and XS0171196727 (144a).

Dealing Disclosure Requirements

Under the provisions of Rule 8.3 of the Takeover Code (the "Code"), if any person is, or becomes indirectly) in 1% or more of any class of "relevant securities" of ScottishPower, all "dealings" of that company (including by means of an option in respect of, or a derivative referenced to, any such "relevant securities") must be publicly disclosed by no later than 3.30pm (London time) on the London business day following the date of the transaction. This requirement will continue until the date on which the offer becomes, or is declared, unconditional, or is otherwise withdrawn or on which the "offer period" otherwise ends. If two or more persons act in concert or in understanding, whether formal or informal, to acquire an "interest" in "relevant" securities" of ScottishPower, they must be treated to be a single person for the purpose of Rule 8.3.

Under the provision of Rule 8.1 of the Code, all "dealings" in "relevant securities" of ScottishPower by the company or its "associates", must be disclosed by no later than 12.00 noon (London time) on the London business day following the relevant transaction.

A disclosure table, giving details of the companies in whose "relevant securities" "dealings" should be disclosed, is set out in the accompanying document.

"Interests in securities" arise, in summary, when a person has long economic exposure, whether on the price of securities. In particular, a person will be treated as having an "interest" by virtue of securities, or by virtue of any option in respect of, or derivative referenced to securities.
